On the way, in the local streets, they will be noting and photographing mathematics such as numbers, shapes, lines, angles and symmetry(both manmade and natural). This forms part of our Robbie Mac Maths Quest. Down at Gardiners Creek, they will switch to geological mode and look at and photograph the terrain and natural and manmade features. They will also look for positive and negative changes (manmade and natural) and the consequences of these for all living things.
